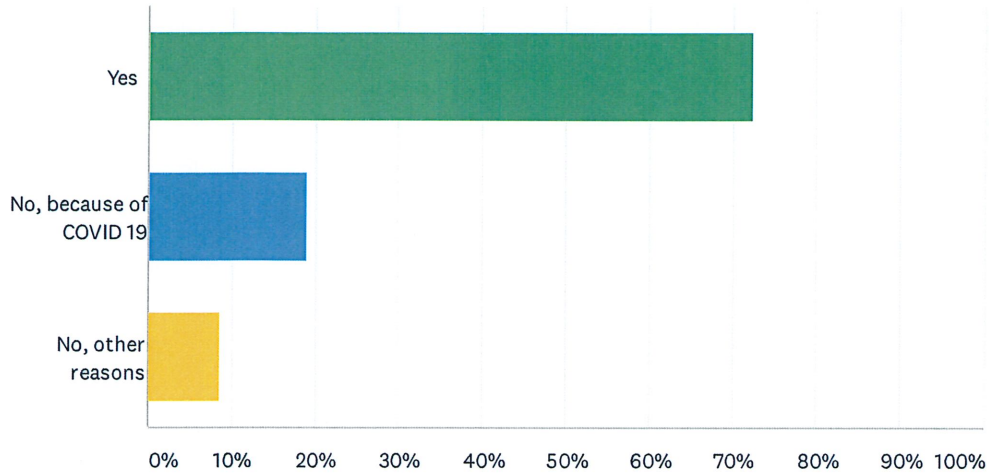


### Q1 Do you think you will be attending Cheese Days on July 17-18-19, 2020?

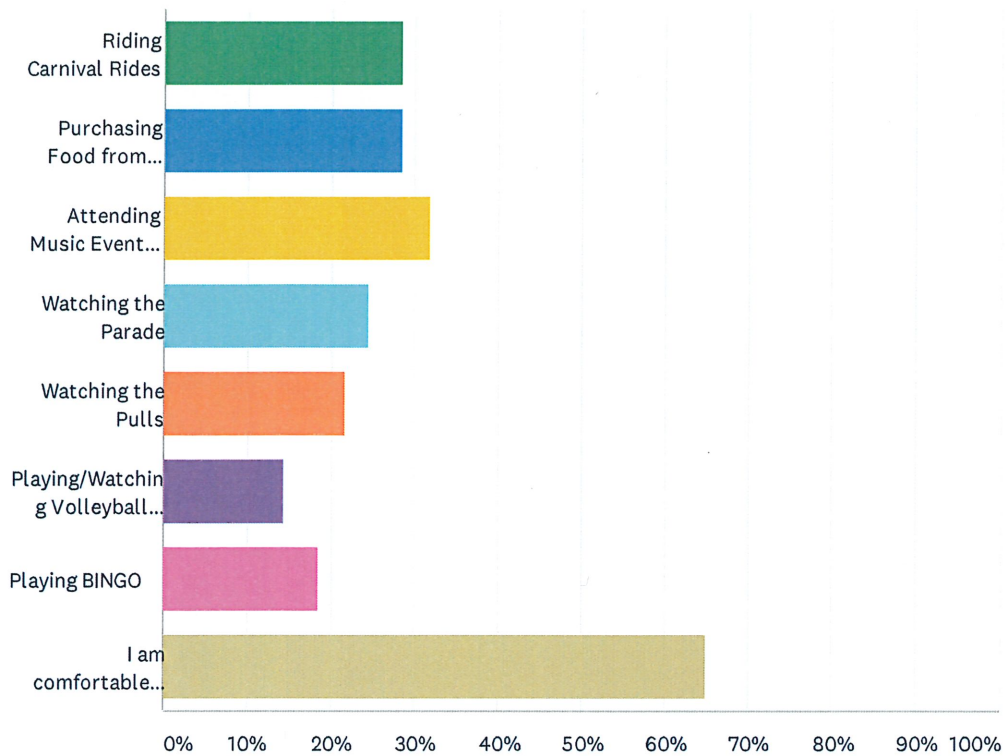

### Q2 If you plan to attend, please select any activities that you would have normally been comfortable doing, but because of COVID 19, will NOT want do in 2020.

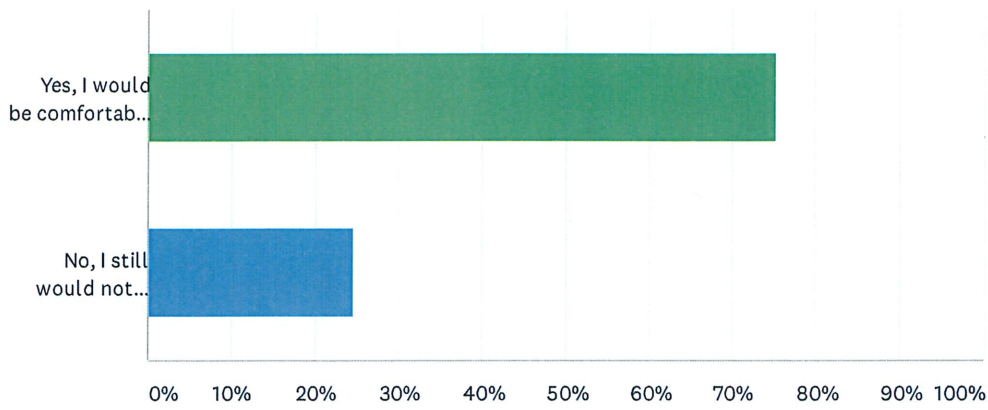

Q3 Would extra hand washing/sanitizing stations along with added cleaning procedures make you feel more comfortable?

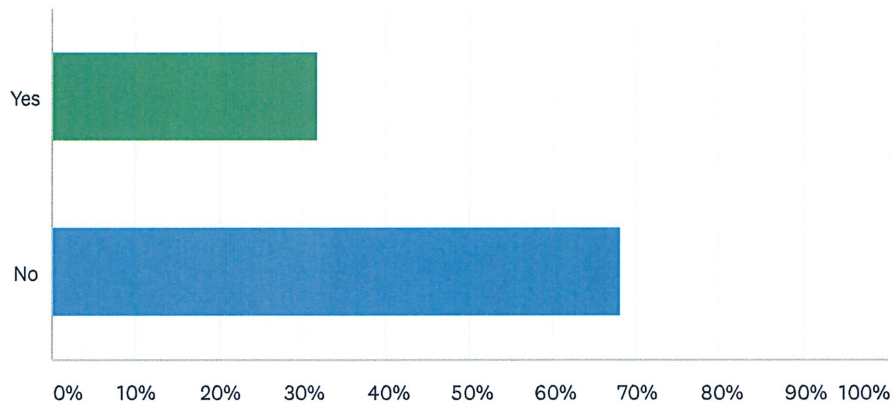

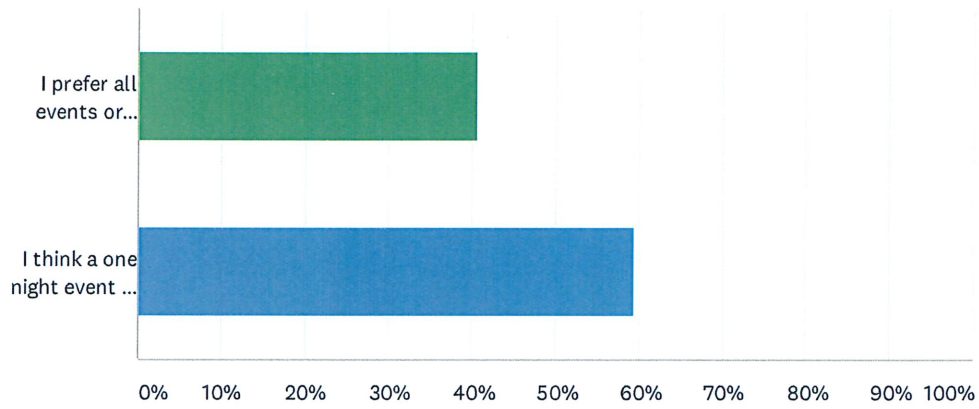
